When it comes preparing your house for a home open, small mistakes could lead to the loss of a sale. To give your home the best chance of selling fast, presentation is essential. Follow this list in preparation for your home open.

## PREPARE IN ADVANCE

- Consider packing and storing non-essential items away in boxes to create more space and less clutter
- Minimize family photos (this helps potential buyers visualize themselves living in the home)
- Organize kitchen cabinets to display how much room you have
- Organize and tidy storage cupboards to create the feeling of more space
- Clean blinds
- Minor maintenance ensure all handles are on draws, check and replace light bulbs

### **INDOORS**

- Clean, clean clean vacuum, mop, dust Don't forget to clean inside ovens, cupboards and wardrobes, in case potential buyers indulge a snoop
- Clean Bathroom toilet seat down, clean mirrors, bathtub, sink. Pack away any hygiene items and cleaning products. Remove any pharmaceuticals
